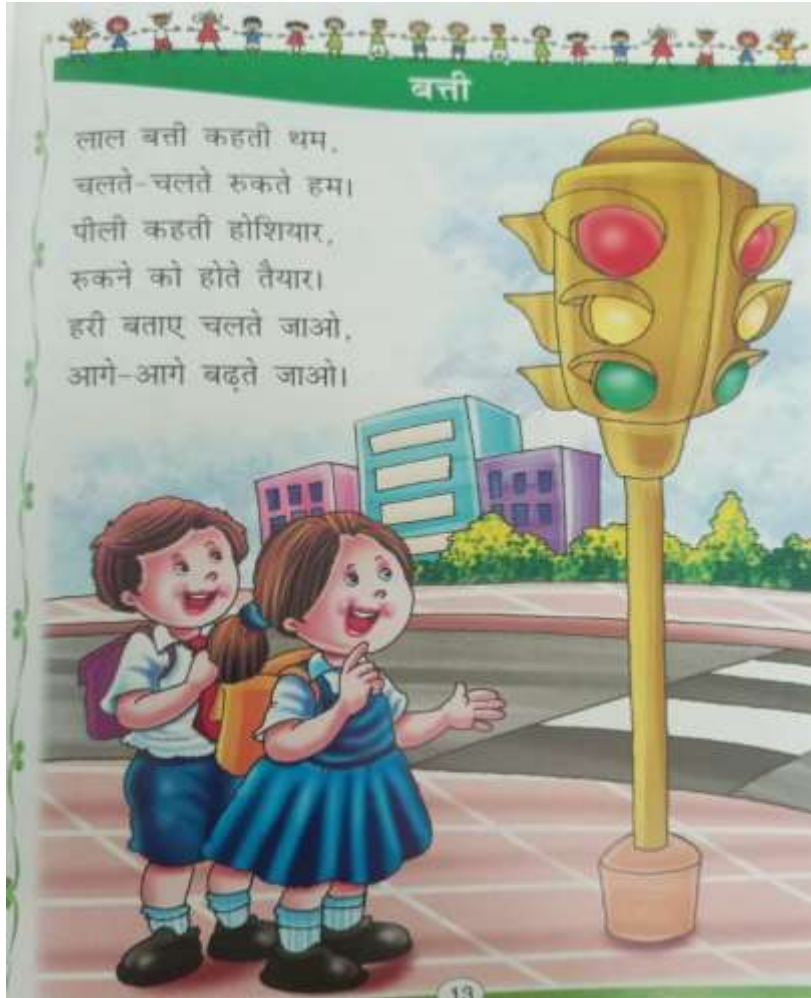
Little Miss Muffet








The crow was very clever and he hit upon an idea. He collected some pebbles and dropped them into the jug. As the level of water rose, he quenched his thirst heartily and flew away.
